



THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MACDONALD

BY-LAW NO. 11/21

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MACDONALD to amend the Rural Municipality of Macdonald By-Law No. 22/06 to restrict use of water within the Municipality.

WHEREAS subsection 232(1) of The Municipal Act provides in part as follows:

Spheres of jurisdiction

232(1) A council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:

- a) the safety, health, protection and well-being of people and the safety and protection of property;
- o) the enforcement of by-laws.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary, expedient and in the best interest of the Rural Municipality of Macdonald to amend By-Law No. 22/06 to ensure the safety and reliability of the Municipal Water Utility for all residents and businesses within the Rural Municipality of Macdonald;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Macdonald in meeting duly assembled, amends By-Law No. 22/06 as follows:

1. Renumber existing 4.4 to 4.5;
2. Add new 4.4 "Sprinkling Restrictions Stage IV"

"If the Manager of Public Works for the Municipality notifies the Chief Administrative Officer of the Municipality that a reduction in water use is necessary requiring Stage IV restrictions, no person shall allow the use of water supplied through the Municipal Water System for any outdoor water use."

3. Add new 4.6

"If Stage IV outdoor water use restrictions are implemented any permits issued under Section 6.1 are deemed to be terminated and no further permits issued under Section 6.1 during the period Stage IV outdoor water use restrictions are in place."

4. Add new 7.2

The provisions of Section 4.4 shall not apply to the following water users which rely upon the steady supply and use of water.

- a. Watering of plants by licensed nurseries;
- b. Wash down of exterior building surfaces or other outdoor surfaces of child care facilities, food and beverage establishments, kennels or animal care facilities where required by health and safety regulations;
- c. Vehicle washing at commercial car washes;
- d. Watering of livestock.
